

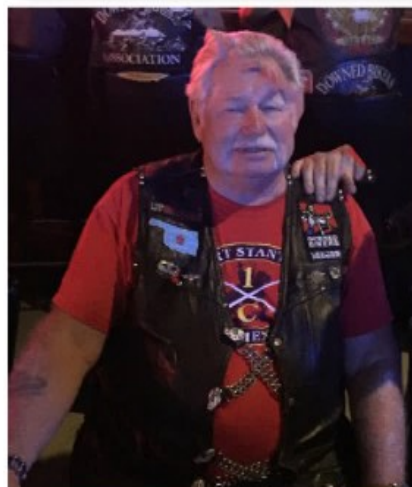

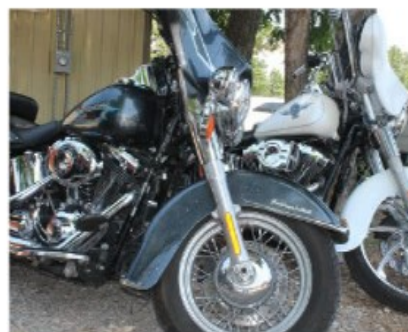

## Medical Marijuana

Oklahoma State Question 788, the "Medical Marijuana Legalization Initiative," was on the ballot and approved in Oklahoma this June. While the vote legalized the licensed cultivation, use and possession of marijuana for medical purposes, the regulations for its implementation are still in the works. Although its clear legal medical marijuana is coming to the state, the details of exactly how this will look aren't yet known. In the meantime, questions abound about what medical marijuana is and how it's delivered.

### Medical Marijuana

According to the National Institutes of Health, Medical marijuana refers to the use of the whole, unprocessed marijuana plant or its basic extracts to treat symptoms of illness and other conditions. Marijuana is derived from the Cannabis sativa plant. It contains more than 100 chemical compounds, called cannabinoids. When ingested or

inhaled, these compounds act on the brain and nerve cells, slowing pain and easing discomfort. Currently, the two main compounds for medical interest are tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) – which creates the "high" – and cannabidiol (CBD).

### Science

While anecdotal evidence of the medicinal benefits of marijuana abound, currently, the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has neither recognized nor approved the use of marijuana plants as medicine. The FDA requires extensive studies in hundreds to thousands of human subjects to assess the risks and benefits of possible medications before approving them for use. These kinds of large-scale clinical trials necessary for FDA approval simply haven't been done. However, scientific studies of cannabinoids have led to FDA-approval of medications that contain cannabinoid

chemicals in pill and liquid form for some uses.

Scientists are currently conducting preclinical and clinical trials with marijuana and its extracts to treat symptoms of illness and other conditions ranging from HIV/Aids, multiple sclerosis and pain to seizures, inflammation, substance abuse disorders and mental disorders. Much remains to be discovered.

### Examples of Medical Marijuana Delivery Methods

Medical marijuana can be consumed in a number of ways. It comes in a variety of different forms, dried, edible or oil.

Smoking is one of the most common methods of consuming marijuana. Although it is one of the fastest ways to feel its effects, it has many of the same health risks as regular smoking.

Vaporizing or Vaping is a quick way to feel the effects of the medication with fewer adverse effects than smoking. Vaping heats the cannabis, creating a vapor that is then inhaled, as opposed to smoking which combusts it, creating smoke that can irritate the throat and lungs.

Marijuana can be mixed into food such as brownies, cookies or candy, referred to as edibles. It can also be brewed as a tea. The effects are long lasting when consumed in this fashion, but they can be slower to kick in. Precise dosing can also be problematic. Because edibles can take the form of gummy bears, lollipops and the like, it is important to keep them out of reach of children who cannot differentiate them from regular candies and sweets.

Tinctures or Sub-Lingual Sprays are made by mixing extracted cannabinoids into alcohol, glycerin solution or Medium Chain Triglyceride Oil "MCT Oil" (often in the form of coconut oil.) These products usually come in a small bottle the contents of which are squirted under the tongue and absorbed through the mouth. These have a mild taste and make it easy to control dosage, but they can be expensive. While the effect is faster than with edibles, it's slower than with inhalation. Tinctures in the form of topicals include, salves, lotions, ointments and sprays. They can be used for skin issues and provide localized pain relief, but many people don't find them effective.

Dabbing uses a cannabis concentrate ("hash oil," "budder," "shatter," "wax," etc.) that is heated at a high temperature, then inhaled. The effect is quick, and it usually delivers a very high dose of THC. Concentrates are at a higher risk of containing harmful chemicals, and the devices that are used to heat the concentrates can be difficult and dangerous to use.

While the scientifically proven benefits of medical marijuana may be overstated by advocates for legalization, research has already shown that there are some legitimate medical uses. As the legal landscape around medical marijuana changes in this state and around the country, more opportunities arise for clinical studies on marijuana's medicinal properties and applications. Further research will help shed light on both the benefits and risks related to its use.

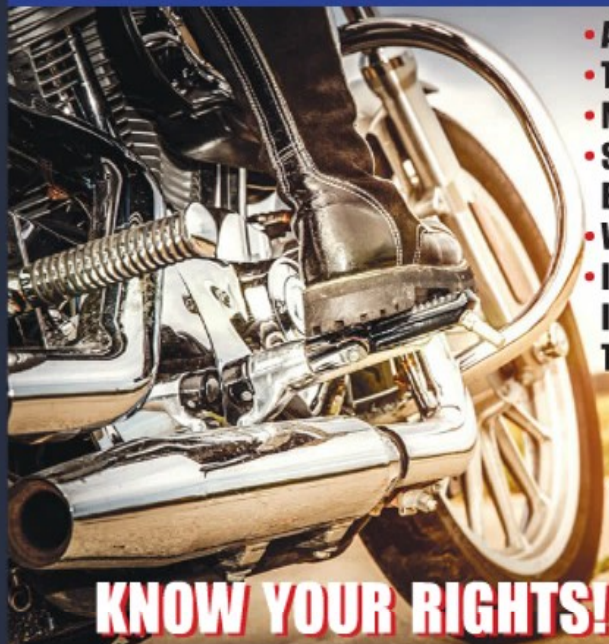
