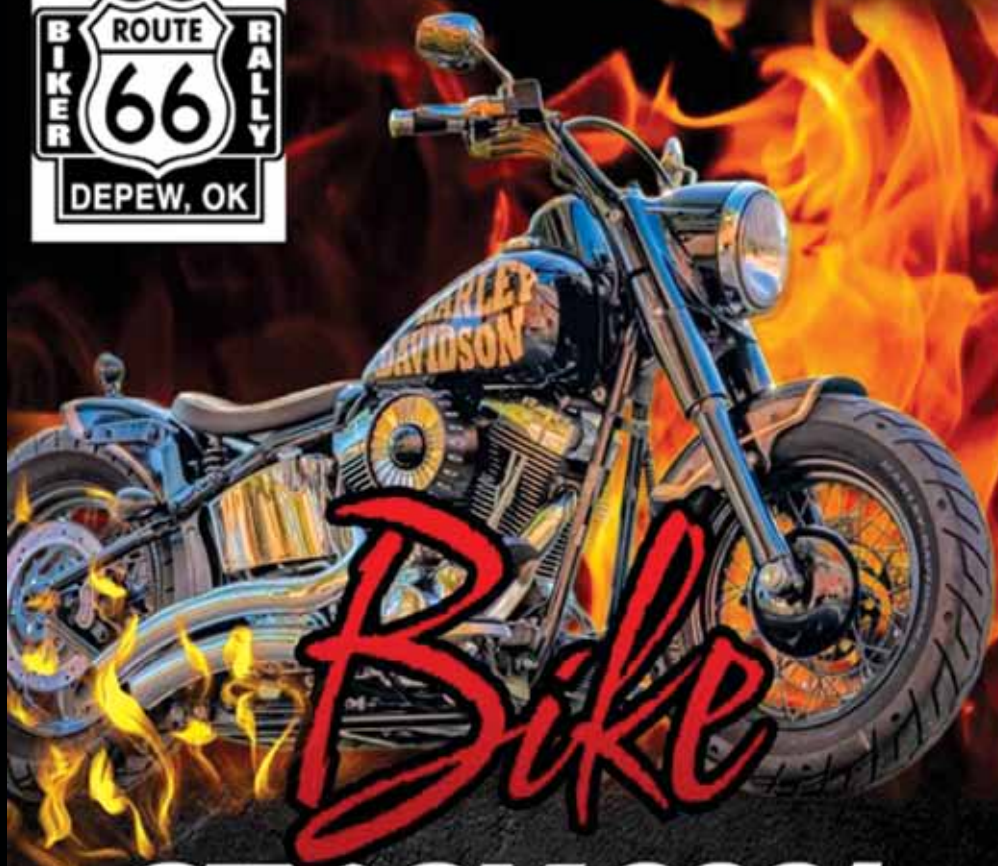

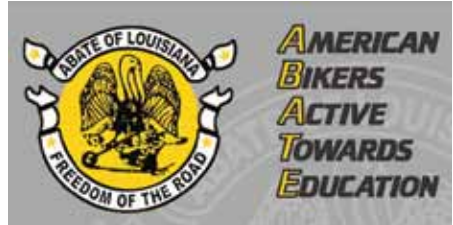

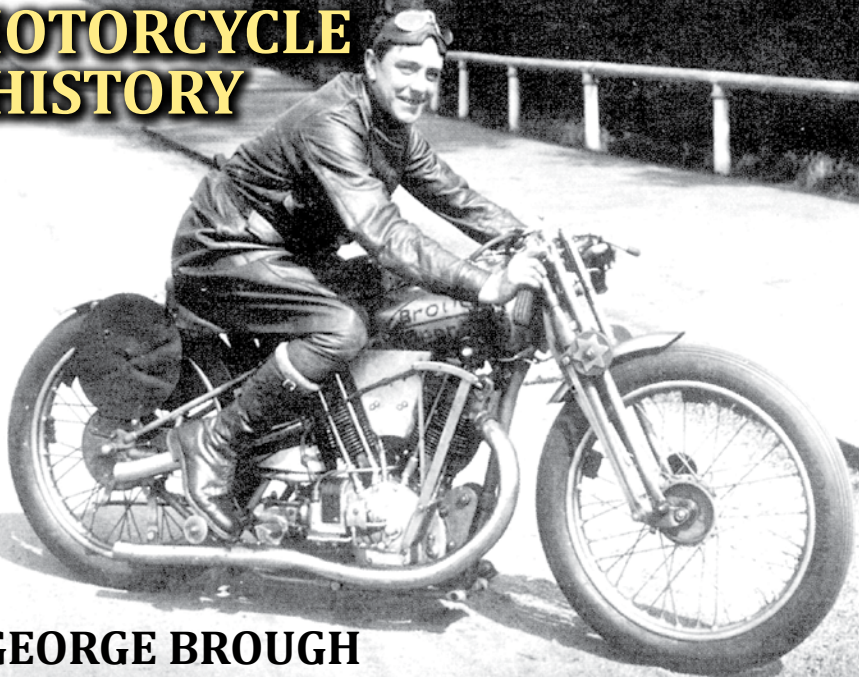

MOTORCYCLE HISTORY



GEORGE BROUGH

On this date, January 12, 1970, George Brough, motorcycle racer, world record holding motorcycle and automobile manufacturer, and showman, died at the age of 79. He was known for his powerful and expensive Brough Superior motorcycles which were the first superbikes.

The name Superior was suggested by a friend but his father reputedly took it personally. George's motorcycles lived up to the claim, however, and he brought together the best components he could find and added distinctive styling details.

He had a flair for marketing and in 1922 rode a Brough Superior SS80 which he called Spit and Polish at Brooklands, managing

an unofficial 100 mph lap. All told, 3,048 motorcycles of 19 models were made in 21 years of production. Most were custom built to customers' requirements and rarely were any two of the same configuration.

Each motorcycle was assembled twice. The first assembly was for fitting of all components, then the motorcycle was disassembled and all parts were painted or plated as needed, then the finished parts were assembled finally. Every motorcycle was test ridden to ensure that it performed to specification, and was certified by George Brough.

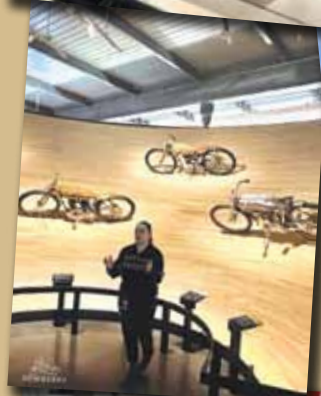

Let's talk

-safety-

CURVES



Spring is one of the most dangerous times for motorcyclists. We are so excited to jump back on our motorcycles we forget that our skills are on a “Use or Lose it” basis. Brushing up on our motorcycle skills, taking a refresher course, or heading to an open parking lot with friends for some good slow-speed challenges are all great ways to shake off the dust of non-riding season. Preparing ourselves by practicing a little on our life-saving crash avoidance maneuvers (braking, swerving, cornering) before taking off on a trip can keep us as “safe as possible” this Spring!

Let's talk a bit about curves and crash avoidance. Curves are one of the places where we crash that is most within our axis of control. Failure to negotiate curves is a single-vehicle crash where the rider

is at fault. In typical scenarios, riders run off the road while cornering or drift into the opposing lane and run head-on into opposing traffic.

Curves are high-level fun and also high-level danger. Riders tend to think slower is safer, but, that is NOT necessarily true. Proper technique is safest. Using proper cornering technique applies at all speeds. Work to master the technique at slower speeds first, then maintain that foundational technique as you add speed. The motorcycle responds positively to proper techniques and poorly to improper techniques. Cornering is a skill that needs a lot of honest self-assessment to recognize weaknesses and then learn and practice better skills. Developing confidence in your cornering technique can add new life to your riding!

Slow, Look, Press, and Roll.
Search, Set up, and Smooth

Enter curves with room to make adjustments if needed. Not too close to the inside OR the outside of the curve. Slow before the curve so that you can accelerate through and out of the curve while pressing the handlebars in the direction of the curve. Be sure throughout this whole time that you look through the curve, keeping your head turned in the direction of the exit of the curve.

Search through the curve, set up (by slowing so you can

accelerate), and then smoothly roll on the throttle coming out of the curves.

Practice, practice, and more practice as Spring comes closer and closer. Like it or not, we are rusty, and practice only helps, it never hurts.

See you in the parking lot to practice a few slow-speed maneuvers before we hit that gorgeous, curvy backroad to kick off Spring Riding Season!

Oklahoma ABATE supports you by sponsoring and promoting these bills. Maybe you should support Oklahoma ABATE?

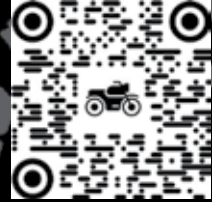
HB 3582 – Lane Filtering – This bill allows motorcycles to ride between the traffic lanes under certain conditions. This is NOT lane splitting. This would only allow bikers to move the front of traffic under very specific conditions that are not yet defined. We are partnering with AMA (American Motorcyclist Association) to pass this bill.

SB 1347 – Handsfree – this bill outlaws use of cell phones while driving unless using handsfree. How many times have we seen cage drivers using their phones for talking or texting while driving.
